CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. ENTRIES

Artists may enter up to two artworks in the Hazelhurst Art Award. The artist must submit a slide or photograph of each work entered accompanied by the Entry Form and fee by 15 October 2001.

2. MEDIUM

The Hazelhurst Art Award is open to original works on/or principally with paper - 2D or 3D is permissible. Acceptable disciplines in the category of Art on Paper include drawing, watercolours, collage, original prints, computer generated, photography, paper sculpture and installation.

3. SELECTION OF WORKS

A selection panel will view all visuals and select the exhibition from all entries received. All works selected for hanging must remain on show for the duration of the exhibition. Notification of selection and non selection for this exhibition will be posted by 29 October 2001.

4. JUDGING

Prior to the exhibition opening, the judge will view all works on display and select one entry for the major award of \$10,000. From the remaining entries, one local artist's* award of \$2,000, courtesy of the Friends of Hazelhurst shall be selected. The decision of the judge will be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

5. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is \$27.50 per art work (non refundable). A maximum of 2 works per artist. Entry forms must be signed by the artist. All fees include GST. Cheques/Money orders are to be made payable to Sutherland Shire Council.

6. SALE OF WORKS

All works exhibited in the Hazelhurst Art Award can be for sale unless marked NFS. A commission of 25% will be deducted from the selling price of any work sold by the Gallery. Artists should be aware of their GST obligations prior to determining the sale price of their artworks and completing the entry form. If you require advice on this matter please call the Australian Taxation Office on 132 478.

7. PREPARATION OF ARTWORKS

Works must be presented ready for exhibition: ie., mounted and framed (if necessary) with appropriate hanging devices attached or supplied, (instructions if necessary). The artist's name, address and phone number, title of work, price or NFS must be clearly marked on the back of each work, and on the entry form.

8. TRANSPORT AND INSURANCE

Forward and return freight is the responsibility of the exhibitor. All transit insurance, forward and return, is to be borne by the entrant. All due care will be taken, however the Gallery or Council accepts no liability for loss or damage during transit. Insurance whilst works are in the Gallery will be covered by Hazelhurst Regional Gallery.

9. RECEIPT OF ENTRIES AND DELIVERY LOCATION

Works selected for the exhibition are to arrive between 8-10 November 2001, from 9.30am until 4.30pm. The works are to be delivered to: Hazelhurst Regional Gallery & Arts Centre, Cnr Talara Road and Kingsway, Gymea. The loading dock is in Talara Road. Ph: (02) 8536 5700

10. COLLECTION OF EXHIBITED WORKS

Exhibitors must collect their works between Monday 10 December and Sunday 16 December between 9.30am and 4.30pm. Works not collected within 14 days of 16 December 2001 shall be disposed of at the discretion of Hazelhurst Regional Gallery.

11. COPYRIGHT

Hazelhurst Regional Gallery & Arts Centre reserves the right to photograph works exhibited in the Hazelhurst Art Award for the purpose of documentation and promotion. All necessary acknowledgments of authorship will be duly made.

12. INTERPRETATION OF THE RULES

In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation of conditions, the decision of Hazelhurst Regional Gallery & Arts Centre shall be binding on all parties.
