Australian Galleries was founded in Melbourne by the Purves family, in which its ownership still remains, in 1956, making it now the longest operating commercial gallery in Australia.

Over the last decade the gallery has gone under rapid expansion and now operates four separate galleries over two states, as well as having its own in house design, production and distribution center.

Apart from handling a great number of significant artists in this country, Australian Galleries has decided to assert a major focus on works on paper, a rich artistic resource that until recently has been considered of lesser importance. The Sydney and Melbourne Works on Paper galleries have a comprehensive stock of prints and drawings, and a broad exhibition program covering all areas of art on paper.
